#### School of... AMBITION

At Westfield Academy, Careers is taught throughout the school curriculum and we are extremely dedicated to preparing students for living and working in the adult world.

Our Post 16 provision is something we are incredibly proud of; actively seeking the development of good quality CEIAG (Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance) and providing students with an introduction to the world of work, skills and opportunity.

In partnership with I2A, (Inspire 2 Achieve) our impartial advice and guidance service aims to help students think realistically about themselves, educating and encouraging them to make reasoned, informed choices about their lifestyle. We have celebrated several nominations and awards over recent years in the Somerset Education Business Partnership Awards (EBP) for our commitment to work related projects as an academy and through staff.

The launch of Talent Academies since 2017 has also provided our students with a wealth of knowledge from local employers. There is the opportunity to explore Aero Engineering, Construction, Dance, Health & Nursing, Manufacturing and Tomorrow's Teachers by engaging in off-site visits to a range of businesses. 2022 will see several new industries added, as well as the re-introduction of in-person events such as Higher Education month and the opportunity to visit local colleges and find out more about what they have to offer.







#### School of... INNOVATION

Continually striving to improve and build on our current facilities makes our academy an exciting and inspiring place for all.

The Creative Arts departments are equipped with many state of the art facilities such as our very own recording studio, 300-seat theatre, and dance studio complete with sprung floor.

Along with our existing 3G astro turf pitch, flood-lit tennis and netball courts and refurbished sports hall, we can also boast the addition of an inflatable sports dome.

We are the first secondary school in Somerset where all students have personal Chromebooks. This enables students to progress faster in an environment where teachers are able to utilise the power of collaboration and the constant visibility of students' work to further develop thinking skills and communication.







#### We are a **COMMUNITY**

Each year group is led by a Head of Year, a non-teaching member of staff devoted to ensuring the health, wellbeing and academic overview of their students. Heads of Year give exceptional pastoral care and alongside the Tutor, provide a go-to for students who wish to discuss any concerns, ideas or achievements.

Upon joining Westfield, all children are assigned to a House; *Darwin, Einstein, Franklin or Galileo*, with each captained by a staff House Leader. Staff are also part of one of these 'Houses'. This helps to build a sense of belonging and family, with regular inter-house events allowing students to experience healthy competitions and compete for further rewards and accolades. Our Houses are also about developing a desire to go "above and beyond".

Over the last few years, we have established a strong link with the local Westfield Community Association by actively taking part in projects to improve the area and fundraise in support of the newly built community centre. We have worked closely with residents to assist them in improving the local area by joining their local gardening scheme. Students have helped "dig, plant & sow", encouraging positive relationships in a range of different age groups .
