Dear Parents/Carers

Re: PE Kit

As we move into the colder months I thought I would take this opportunity to remind parents and carers of our PE kit policy, especially to clarify what students are allowed to wear to ensure they stay warm during outdoor lessons.

Students must wear their PE kit to school on the days they have PE lessons. Lessons will continue to be practical and all activities will be in line with guidelines from each national governing body e.g. The FA, England Netball etc. Due to the need to maintain bubbles and the current guidance on physical activity, access to indoor teaching spaces will be extremely limited.

As lessons will continue outdoors throughout the winter, students will need to be prepared for inclement weather, particularly cold temperatures. We highly recommend that students wear multiple layers e.g. a base layer, Westfield polo shirt and Westfield rugby top. Orders received before Monday 7 December can be delivered to school on Friday 11 December. From January orders will be delivered to school on the third Friday of every month.

Please note, students are not allowed to wear non-Westfield branded kit.
