WORK EXPERIENCE WEEK

A reminder that Year 10 need to submit their Work Experience paperwork to the Careers Team, once they have secured a placement.

Our dates are from Monday 28th March - Friday 1st April.

Advice and guidance has been the theme during our Wider Curriculum time last term and students have been practising how to contact Employers. Well done to those students who have obtained a placement already - we have booked over 110 students so far!

This term will focus on getting ready for the week, with students looking at what they need to wear, the timings of their week out and what to expect. They will each be given a Work Experience booklet to complete and then this is taken with them to their placement, to share with their Employer and keep track of what they do each day. We are currently busy organising the staff visits for that week and are very much looking forward to seeing the students in action and finding out how the week is progressing.

INTERVIEW PRACTICE DAY

On Tuesday 8th February, we have a team of volunteers coming in from the Wildcat Department at Leonardo, to host a Mock Interview Day for our Year 11 cohort.

This scheme gives our young people the opportunity to develop and demonstrate their potential, as well as experience a formal interview process. Students will follow a brief, answer questions and be expected to look smart! We will be very pleased to welcome the volunteer team back again after it being postponed for several years. Past students thoroughly enjoyed the experience and said it boosted their confidence. We are planning the Year 10 day for the Spring.

NATIONAL CITIZEN SERVICE

NCS is designed for 16 and 17 year olds and provides many opportunities to get involved with your local community, take part in residentials, group work, make new friends and gain new skills. Reach your potential with NHS Cadets and learn the skills you need to support vital healthcare teams across the country.

NHS Cadets is a new scheme created by St John Ambulance in partnership with the NHS, providing opportunities to explore skills, knowledge and volunteering roles within healthcare. It is aimed at young people aged 14 to 18 who are from communities currently under-represented within the NHS and St John Ambulance.

The programme offers young people health awareness sessions, courses to develop their leadership and communication skills and an insight or experience in volunteering within the NHS.

It is a free programme, consisting of weekly, 2-hour sessions for 11 months. Cadets will be supported throughout their volunteering journey by our NHS Cadets Team.

Who can get involved?

The initiative is seeking young people who might not have previously considered volunteering in healthcare. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Young people living with learning difficulties and / or disabilities (we will need to discuss if we have the support network to help you participate)
- Young people in the care system, or recent care leavers
- Refugees or Asylum Seekers
- Young Carers
- Homeless young people
- Those not in education, employment or training, or those with school results lower than you hoped/need
- Those living with mental health concerns (same principle as anyone with a learning difficulty or disability)
- Those who identify as being part of the LGBTQI+ community (lesbian, gav. bisexual, transgender, gueer intersex+)
- Those coming from low-income families /young people in receipt of free
- Young people from ethnic minority communities

How do I get involved?

New groups will be opening during 2022, and by 2023 we expect 10,000 young people will have enrolled as an NHS Cadet.

With the ongoing pandemic it is likely that some programmes will continue to be delivered virtually, with a look to face-to-face sessions in the near future. Please ensure that you will be able to travel to the delivery location, as well as access Microsoft Teams.
