

SUMMARY OF PUPIL PREMIUM EXPENDITURE 2015/16

Westfield Academy received £194,766 in pupil premium funding for the year ending August 31st 2016.

In 2015/16 there were 208 Pupil Premium students which makes up 28% of the school population.

Disadvantaged students comprised 30 out of the cohort of 147 (20%) taking GCSE exams in 2016. Of these, the most able 15 students made progress comparable with their peers, whilst the progress of the least able was below that of their peers. This information has been used to direct 2016/2017 funding.

In 2015/2016 Westfield Academy allocated Pupil Premium funding in the following ways:

Year 7 literacy and numeracy catch up funding for 2015-2016 totalled £12,500. This money was spent on providing support for year 7 students identified as having low reading age or numeracy scores. Support provided mainly through Rapd Reader, Numicon and spelling interventions.
