

SUMMARY OF PUPIL PREMIUM EXPENDITURE 2014/15

Westfield Academy received £185,958 in pupil premium funding for the year ending August 31st 2015.

In 2014/15 there were 219 Pupil Premium students which makes up 30% of the school population.
