Access Arrangements for GCSE Examinations

Some students with a recognised SEN diagnosis are entitled to special provision for their GCSEs e.g. extra time, a reader, use of a scribe, small room. Miss Francis will inform parents if a student qualifies for Access Arrangements.

Tests for these are usually held in the summer term of Year 9 or early in the Autumn Term of Year 10 so that Examination Boards can be contacted and necessary paperwork completed.
